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shares of common stock of the Issuer equal to the number of shares subject to the Old Marshall & Ilsley option multiplied by a ratio, the numerator of which was the closing price per share Old Marshall & Ilsley common stock on the date immediately prior to the share distribution (the ?Pre-distribution Stock Price?) and the denominator of which was the average closing price per share of Issuer common stock over the sixth through tenth business days following the date of the share distribution (the ?Post-distribution Stock Price?). The adjusted exercise price of each converted option is equal to the exercise price per share of Old Marshall & Ilsley common stock subject to such option immediately prior to the share distribution divided by the quotient obtained by dividing the Pre-distribution Stock Price by the Post-distribution Stock Price.
