

Item 7.01. Regulation FD Disclosure

On January 22, 2014, Global Partners LP (the “Partnership”) issued a press release announcing that the Board of Directors of its general partner, Global GP LLC, declared a quarterly cash distribution of \$0.6125 per unit (\$2.45 per unit on an annualized basis) on all of its outstanding common units for the period from October 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013. This distribution represents an increase of approximately 2% over the quarterly distribution of \$0.60 per unit paid in November 2013 and an increase of approximately 7.5% over the quarterly distribution of \$0.57 per unit paid in February 2013. On February 14, 2014, the Partnership will pay such cash distribution to its common unitholders of record as of the close of business February 5, 2014. A copy of the Partnership’s press release is attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 and incorporated herein by reference.

In accordance with General Instruction B.2 of Form 8-K, the information set forth in this Item 7.01 and in Exhibit 99.1 shall not be deemed to be “filed” for the purposes of Section 18 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the “Exchange Act”), or otherwise subject to the liabilities of that section, unless the Partnership specifically states that the information is to be considered “filed” under the Exchange Act or incorporates it by reference into a filing under the Exchange Act or the Securities Act of 1933, as amended.
