(1) One-third of the options vested on August 23, 2005, the remaining options vest in equal monthly installments over the two year period commencing on August 23, 2005, for each month the grantee remains an employee.

(2) One-third of the restricted stock units vested on August 23, 2005, the remaining restricted stock units vest in equal monthly installments over the two year period commencing on August 23, 2005, for each month the grantee remains an employee. Vested stock units settle periodically beginning in 2006 until August 24, 2007.

(3) Restricted Stock Units settle in Common Stock on a 1:1 basis.

(4) One-third of the restricted stock units vest on February 1, 2006, the remaining restricted stock units vest in equal quarterly installments over the two year period commencing on February 1, 2006, for each quarter the grantee remains an employee.

(5) Under the Core-Mark Holding Company, Inc. 2005 Long Term Incentive Plan, the amount of common stock issuable upon the settlement of the restricted stock units will be determined by the number of shares having a market value of \$374,080, based on the average closing price of the company's common stock over the eleventh through twentieth trading days following the date that the company's common stock becomes listed for quotation on the NASDAQ National Market.
