(1) Includes 19,920 shares of Class A Common shares issued on January 24, 2008, pursuant to the Issuer's Second Amended and Restated 2000 Equity Incentive Plan, which shares vest on January 24, 2011.

(2) Includes 12,500 shares of Class A common stock held for the account of Reporting Person's grandchildren, the custodian of which accounts is Reporting Person's spouse. Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership of all the shares of Class A common stock held by the Reporting Person's spouse.

(3) Vesting may accelerate as follows: (a) on 3/31/09, 1/3 of the options will vest if the Class A Common Stock (the "Common Stock") has traded at \$7.00 or more for at least 10 consecutive trading days (a "10-day period") during the year ending on such date; 2/3 of the options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$9.50 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date or all of the options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$12.00 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date; and (b) on 3/31/10, 1/3 of the unvested options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$7.00 or more for a 10-day period during the two years ending on such date; 2/3 of the unvested options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$9.50 or more for a 10-day period during the two years ending on such date; or all of the unvested options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$12.00 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date.

(4) Vesting may accelerate as follows: (a) On 10/21/10, 1/3 of the Options will vest if the Class A Common Stock ("Common Stock") has traded at \$2.75 or more for at least 10 consecutive trading days (a "10-day period") during the year ending on such date; 2/3 of the unvested Options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$3.75 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date; or all of the unvested Options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$5.00 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date; and (b) on 10/21/11, 1/3 of the unvested Options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$2.75 or more for a 10-day period during the two years ending on such date; 2/3 of the unvested Options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$3.75 or more for a 10-day period during the two years ending on such date; or all of the unvested Options will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$5.00 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date.

(5) Each restricted stock unit (an "RSU") represents a contingent right to receive one share of Common Stock; however, the Issuer has the discretion to settle in Common Stock or cash or a combination thereof.

(6) Vesting may accelerate as follows: (a) On 4/23/10, 1/3 of the RSUs will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$7.00 or more for at least 10 consecutive trading days (a "10-day period") during the year ending on such date; 2/3 of the RSUs will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$9.50 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date; or all of the unvested RSUs will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$12.00 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date; and (b) On 4/23/11, 1/3 of the unvested RSUs will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$7.00 or more for a 10-day period during the two years ending on such date; 2/3 of the unvested RSUs will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$9.50 or more for a 10-day period during the two years ending on such date; or all of the unvested RSUs will vest if the Common Stock has traded at \$12.00 or more for a 10-day period during the year ending on such date.

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
